NOTICE OF THE OFFICIAL CALL FOR THE MASS MEETING OF THE KING WILLIAM COUNTY REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE

As Chairman of the King William County Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia (RPV), and pursuant to the RPV Plan of Organization and in compliance with the King William County Republican Committee Bylaws, I, John Hubbard, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Pamunkey Regional Library-Upper King William Branch, 694-J Sharon Road, King William, VA 23086 on April 18, 2019 starting at 6:00 p.m. for the following purposes:

- 1) To elect up to 164 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia 97th Legislative District Convention at Hanover High School, 10307 Chamberlayne Road, Mechanicsville, VA 23116, starting at 10:00 a.m. (registration starting at 8:00 a.m.) local time on Saturday, May 4, 2019, for the purposes of nominating a Republican candidate for the office of the Virginia House of Delegates, 97th District, to be voted for in the general election on Tuesday, November 5, 2019. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 225 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that King William County Republican Committee is entitled to 32.76 Delegate Votes;
- 2) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of the County of King William, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party in the last five years. A single exception to the above shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support all of the nominees of the Republican Party in the ensuing election. A voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a Party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception as identified in this paragraph thereafter.

In order to be eligible for election as a Delegate or Alternate Delegate to any convention, an individual must be registered to vote no later than the Pre-Filing deadline established by the Official Committee. A person who has made application for registration and meets all other requirements herein, but whose name does not appear on the local registration books solely because of the books having been closed in connection with a local election, will nevertheless be

deemed a legal and qualified voter. Active Duty Military registered to vote in King William County and in accord with Republican Principles may participate in this Mass Meeting and in the Republican Party of Virginia District Legislative Convention. DoD Directive 344.10 and The Republican Party of Virginia Plan of Organization provides for participation with some restrictions such as not attending in uniform, not identifying yourself by your rank or service position, and not implying official Military support of the Party or a particular candidate.

Pre-Filing Requirements

Any person who wishes to be a Delegate or Alternate Delegate to the 97th Legislative District Convention must complete the Delegate Filing Form to include their full legal name, their address, phone number and email address if they have one. The Delegate Filing Form must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. DST, April 9, 2019 either in person to John Hubbard at: Offices of 3 Rivers Services LLC, 115 Commerce Park Drive, Suite E, Manquin, Va. 23106 or by regular mail, postmarks shall not govern, at the following address: King William County Republican Committee, Offices of 3 Rivers Services LLC, 115 Commerce Park Drive, Suite E, Manquin, Va. 23106. Delegate Filing Forms must bear the original signature of the person seeking election as a delegate. Each duly filed candidate seeking the nomination may, at their discretion, have one representative present to witness the closing of the deadline and to receive a count of the total number of Pre-File forms received.

Only those who have properly Pre-Filed can be nominated at the Mass Meeting. No nominations may be made from the floor of the Mass Meeting for any Delegate, by virtue of the Pre-Filing requirements. If fewer than the maximum number of delegates to the 97th Legislative District Convention files for election, all qualified delegates shall be declared elected and the Mass Meeting shall be canceled by the Chairman.

Properly Pre-Filed Delegates to 97th Legislative District Convention need NOT attend the Mass Meeting on April 18, 2019, to be elected a Delegate to the 97th Legislative District Convention.

Resolutions

Resolutions must be submitted by the Pre-File Deadline (April 9) to the King William Chairman to be considered by the Resolutions Committee. No Resolutions may be submitted from the floor of the Mass Meeting.

Registration and Fees

The doors will open at 5:30 p.m. with registration to begin at the same time. Any participant in line at 6:10 p.m. shall be allowed to register for the Mass Meeting. There will be no registration fee to participate in the King William County Republican Mass Meeting. A current voter registration card would help expedite the registration process.
