Official Call for a Mass Meeting of Greene County By the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Greene County Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee and the Executive Committee, I, Edward A. Yensho, do hereby issue this Call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the <u>Greene County Court House</u>, 22 Court Street, Stanardsville, Virginia 22973 or its alternate site as determined by the Chairman, beginning at 7:00 p.m. EDT on Monday, May 6th, 2019. Registration begins at 5:30 p.m. EDT. The primary purpose of the Mass Meeting is:

- 1. Electing a candidate to represent the Republican Party in the November 5th, 2019 General Election for the position of Commonwealth Attorney of Greene County.
- 2. Electing a candidate to represent the Republican Party in the November 5th, 2019 General Election for the position of Board of Supervisor-at-Large for Greene County.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Greene County, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing, as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nominating process of a party other than the Republican Party in the last five years from March 1, 2014. A single exception to this restriction shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that they are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future.

For Mass Meeting registration, all participants shall be required to provide proof of identity in the form of a valid government or employer-issued photo identification, or by signing an affidavit of identity. Only those individuals who are registered at the Mass Meeting by 7:00 p.m. EDT on May 6th, 2019, or who are in line for registration by that time, will be entitled to register and participate in the Mass Meeting.

Pre-filing Requirements for Candidates

Candidates for Commonwealth Attorney of Greene County or for Supervisor-at-Large must submit an official form, by mail only, to the Greene County Republican Committee, P.O. Box 933, Stanardsville, VA 22973. The official form can be down loaded at www.gcrcgop.com or www.virginia.gop. All official forms and a non-refundable filing fee of \$200.00 (check or money order made payable to Greene County Republican Committee) must be mailed and received by 6:00 p.m. EDT, March 28th, 2019, and post marks will not govern. Nominations for candidates for Commonwealth Attorney or Board of Supervisor-at-Large will not be permitted from the floor of the Mass Meeting.

If there is only one qualified pre-filed candidate for Commonwealth Attorney of Greene County or for Board of Supervisor-at-Large, the said candidate will be deemed elected and that part of the Mass Meeting will be canceled. If there is no qualified pre-filed candidate for both positions, the Mass Meeting will be canceled.

Registration Fee

For the Greene County Mass Meeting there will be no registration fees required to participate.
