2023 Party Canvass of the Craig County Republican Party for Craig Creek District Board of Supervisors Member

Qualifications for Participation. All legal and qualified voters of the Craig Creek Magisterial District of Craig County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. Voters will be required to present a validly issued photographic identification as defined by the Virginia Department of Elections. No voter who refuses to present such identification will be permitted to vote.

Filing Requirements Candidates for the nomination or election at said canvass shall file a written statement by mail or in person (application attached), and pay a \$40 filing fee to Susan Edwards, 1004 Craig Woods Rd, New Castle, VA 24127 which must be received not later than 5 P.M. on April, 7th. If not more than the number of persons to be elected shall file, then such properly filed persons shall be declared nominated, and no canvass will be held for such purpose. Postmarks shall not govern.

Approval/Publication/Revisions

The Craig County Republican Committee voted at a duly called meeting to approve the terms of this Call and to waive publication of this Call in a newspaper. The Executive Committee of the Craig County Republican Committee is authorized to make technical changes if required, change the location of any Canvass site if any of the above-chosen locations is not available, and to adopt rules by which the canvass will operate.
