# Mass Meeting of the King William County Republican Committee

Saturday, March 30, 2024 at 11:00 am, EST King William Parks and Rec. Building 7890 Richmond Tappahannock Hwy King William, VA 23086

As Chairman of the King William County Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Lindsay May Robinson, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held on Saturday, March 30, 2024 at 11:00 am, EST or an alternate location, for the following purposes:

- a) Electing a Unit Chairman
- b) Electing up to 220 members of the Unit Committee
- c) Electing 220 Delegates and 220 Alternates to the 1st Congressional District Convention as listed below:
- d) Electing 220 Delegates and 220 Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia Quadrennial State Convention as listed below:

### **1st Congressional District Convention:**

The 1st Congressional District of the Republican Party of Virginia will be held at King William High School, 80 Cavalier Dr, King William, VA 23086-3657, or its alternate site, starting at 10:00 a.m. local time, with registration beginning at 8:00 a.m. local time, on Saturday, May 4, 2024, for the following purposes:

- 1) Electing a District Chairman of the Republican Party;
- 2) Electing three (3) Members of the State Central Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia;
- 3) Electing a Republican candidate for Elector for President and Vice President of the United States for the election to be held on November 5, 2024; and
- 4) For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention.

The District Convention comprises delegates and alternate delegates based on a percentage of the total number of Republican votes cast in each county and city in the last gubernatorial and presidential elections combined. The maximum number of delegates for each unit is up to five times its respective Delegate Vote. The maximum number of delegates and alternate delegates allowed for King William County is 440. If you want to be a delegate, follow the pre-filing instructions and submit the form with the specified filing fee. Candidates for the Chairman, Members of the State Central Committee, and Elector positions should submit their candidate declarations and fees in writing directly to the 1st Congressional District Republican Committee.

The State Convention is on May 31, 2024, beginning at 2:30 PM to be held at the Hampton Roads Convention Center to adopt the rules of the convention. The election of Chairman, National Committeeman and Committeewoman and electors is on June 1, 2024, beginning at 10:00 am. Delegates and alternate delegates will represent units based on Republican votes in each county and city in the last gubernatorial and presidential elections. Each unit has at least one (1) Delegate Vote and its maximum number of delegates can go up to five (5) times its corresponding Delegate Vote.

## **Qualifications for Participation**

All legal and qualified voters of King William County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin, or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia (RPV) in the King William County Republican Party Mass Meeting and the 1st District Convention and/or the RPV 2024 Quadrennial Convention subject to the provisions in Article I and Article VII section C of the RPV Plan of Organization . In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party within the last five years.

A single exception shall be approved for a voter who renounces affiliation with any other party in writing and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party shall not have the benefit of the exception thereafter. Party mass meetings voters must present one of the forms of identification listed in Title 24.2-643 of the Code of Virginia to participate.

The First Congressional district and the RPV State Convention adhere to the participation guidelines specified in the Republican Party of Virginia Plan of Organization for Military Members. These guidelines are described in all three convention calls available on www.virginia.gop .

#### Filing Requirements for King William County Republican Committee Unit Chairman

Candidates must submit a written statement of intent and fees to Lindsay M. Robinson by mail PO Box 322, Manquin, VA 23106 or in person at 1375 Acquinton Church Rd, King William, VA 23086. Filing fees are \$100 for Unit Chairman. Payment by check (in person or by mail) or cash (in-person only). The statement of intent and fees must be received no later than Friday, March 15, 2024, at 5:00 PM local time. Postmarks shall not govern.

# Filing Requirements for King William County Republican Committee Unit Members

Candidates for Membership in the King William County Republican Committee must submit a official filing form (see page 5), Chairman Lindsay M. Robinson by mail PO Box 322, Manquin, VA 23106 or in person at 1375 Acquinton Church Rd, King William, VA 23086. There are no fees for candidates for membership. The statement of intent must be received no later than Friday, March 15, 2024, at 5:00 PM local time. Postmarks shall not govern.

## **Filing Requirements for Convention Delegates**

Candidates for Delegate or Alternate Delegate representing King William County at the 1st Congressional District Convention and/or the RPV 2024 Quadrennial Convention must submit the Official King William County Republican Party Pre-File Form (see page 4) along with the appropriate filing fee(s) to Chairman Lindsay M. Robinson by mail PO Box 322, Manquin, VA 23106 or in person at 1375 Acquinton Church Rd, King William, VA 23086. The filing fees vary depending on which convention you are filing for - \$10.00 for the 1st District Convention, and \$45.00 for the State Convention - and should be made payable to "KWCRC". Please note that the filing fees and official filing form must be received no later than Friday, March 15, 2024 , at 5:00 PM local time. Postmarks shall not govern.

#### Cancellation

If the number of candidates, qualified under Article I of the State Party Plan, who properly file for any of the offices to be elected by this Mass Meeting does not exceed the maximum number who can be elected, then that portion of the Mass Meeting will not be held and those candidates who have been certified by the Credentials Committee shall be declared elected to the positions for which they have filed. If this applies to all offices to be elected by this Mass Meeting, the Mass Meeting, shall be canceled. A cancellation notice will be posted on the Republican Party of Virginia website, www.virginia.gop/event.

#### **Publication**

Publication of this Official Call shall be posted on the website of the Republican Party of Virginia www.virginia.gop and the Facebook page of the King William County Republican Committee. The King William County Republican Committee has waived the newspaper publication requirement by more than a two-thirds vote.

#### **Call Revisions**

If necessary, the unit's chairman may modify the Call that was issued to include any technical or conforming changes and is required to notify the Unit Committee of such changes promptly.

### **Registration Fee**

There will be no registration fee to participate in this Mass Meeting.
